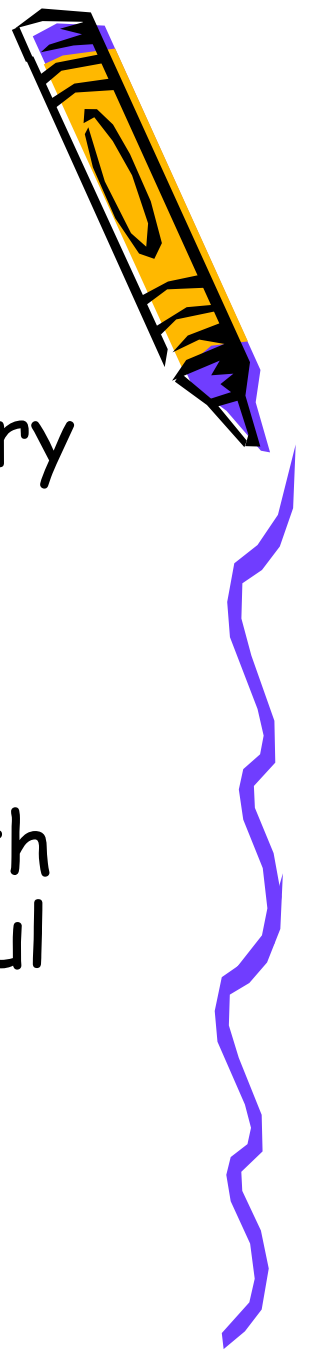
Title I



- Title I is the nation's largest federal program for schools.



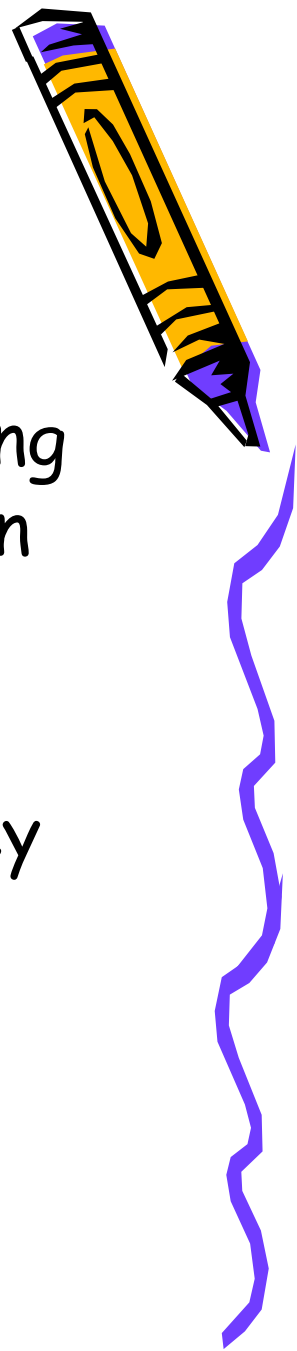
More about Title I

How does Title I work?

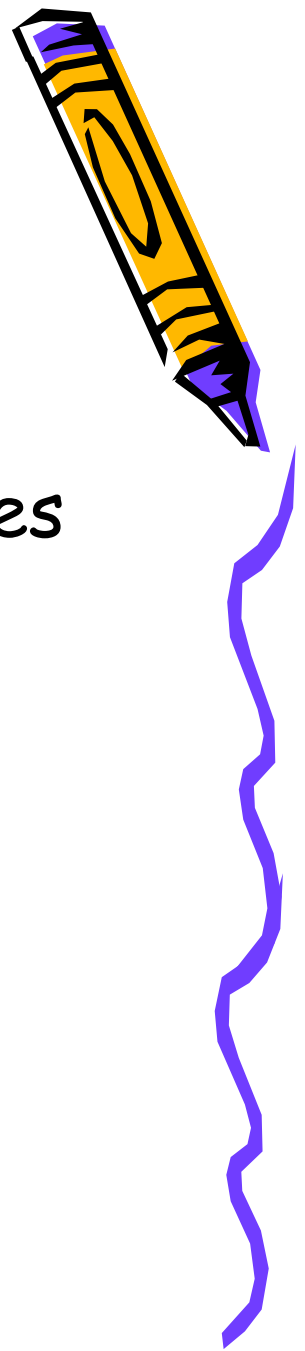


- The federal government provides funding to our state. Each state must submit an educational plan.
- The WV Dept. of Education sends money to Mason Co. based on the number of families below a set income level.

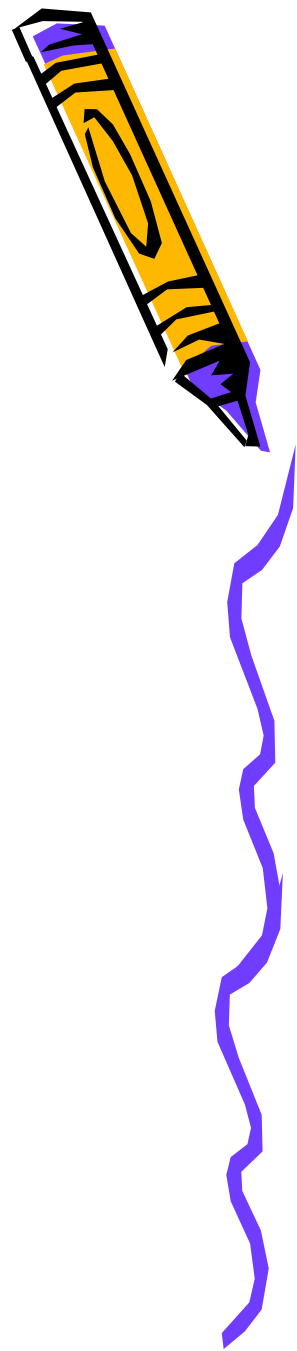


How does Title I work?

- The Mason Co. Board of Education identifies eligible schools and distributes Title I resources.
- Leon Elementary works to identify students in need of help, sets goals for improvement, develops instructional programs, and involves parents in the program.

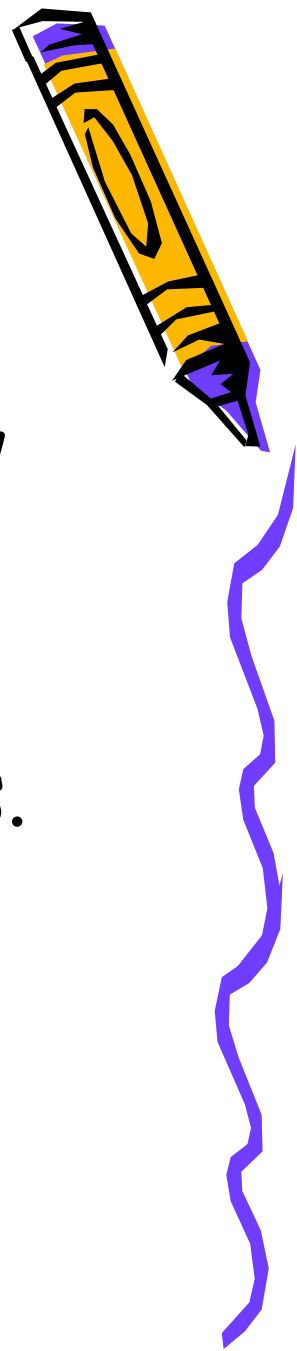

Help your child get the most out of school

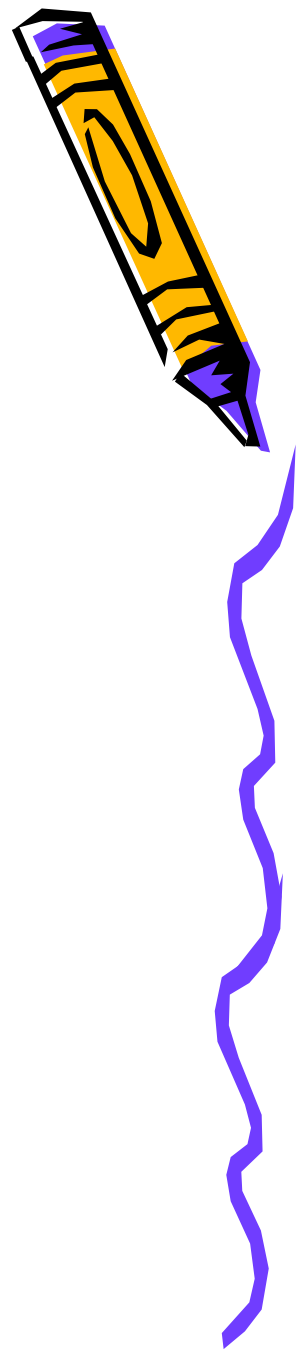


- Set good examples by showing how schoolwork relates to daily life.

- Spend quality time with your child.

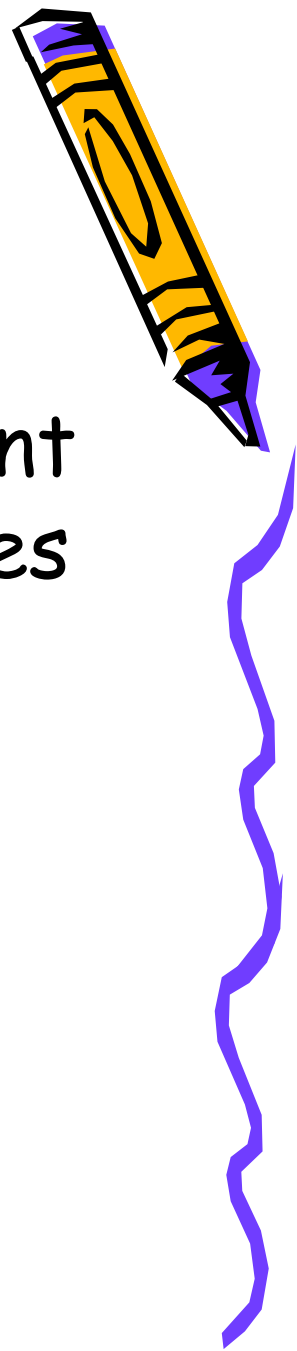


Help your child get the most out of school

- Read with your child.



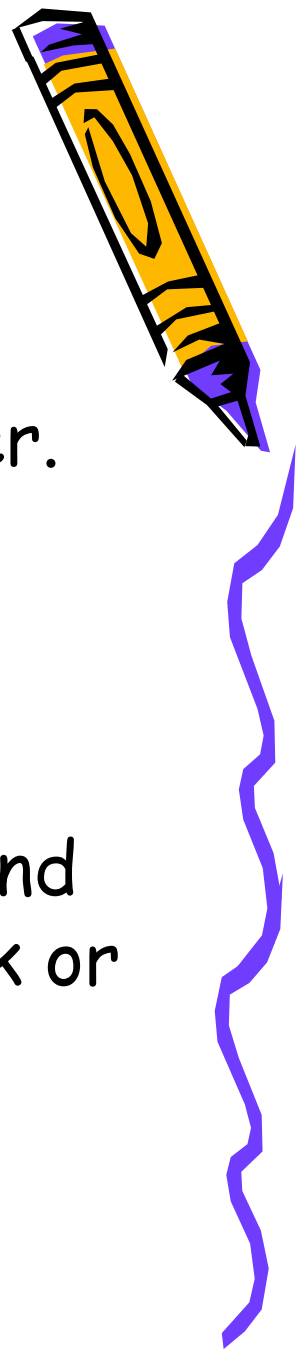
Be a part of Title I's success!

- Join PTO

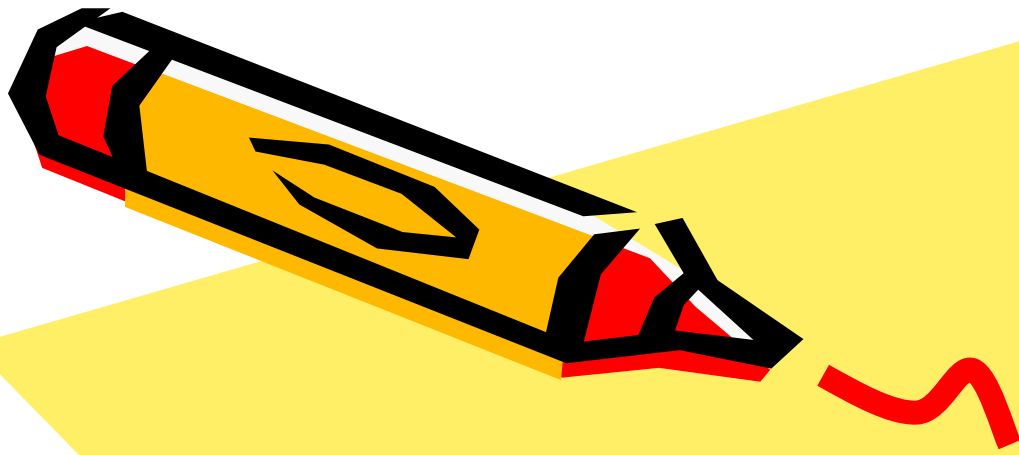


Be aware of your child's performance.
